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Pacific Press® Names Daniel Royo Vice President for Product Development



Nampa, Idaho (December 9, 2025) — On Thursday, December 4, 2025, the Pacific Press® Board of Directors voted to invite Dr. Daniel Royo, PhD, to serve as vice president for Product Development. Royo replaces Miguel Valdivia, PhD, who retired after serving Pacific Press® for nearly 35 years as book editor, editor of *El Centinela*, and vice president for Product Development.

Prior to accepting his new responsibilities, Royo served at Pacific Press® as the editor for trade books and acquisitions for just under a year. Daniel, his wife Danielle, and their three children moved to Idaho from Maryland, where he had served as a local church pastor in the Potomac Conference for almost 20 years.

Royo graduated from Southern Adventist University with a bachelor of arts in theology and from the Adventist Theological Seminary at Andrews University with a master of divinity. He also holds two degrees from the Kearley Graduate School of Theology at Faulkner University, master of philosophy and doctor of philosophy in biblical studies. Daniel is bilingual in English and Spanish and, since arriving at Pacific Press®, has written articles for *El Centinela* and *Revista Adventista*.
