

Great Hope Sent Around the World

Nampa, Idaho (July 8, 2013) — Tumaini Kuu is Swahili for The Great Hope and within the next couple days, 600,000 copies of this 400+ page translation of The Great Controversy will ship from Pacific Press® in Nampa, Idaho to three countries in the East Central Africa Division: Tanzania, Kenya, and the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

The books will be packed onto 275 pallets and shipped in 15 containers with a total weight of 450,000 lbs. It will take about two months for the shipment to reach its destination. Once there, the books will be used for evangelistic campaigns in the East Central Africa Division.
