- The birth flowers for August are gladiolus
- In 8 BC Sextilis (sixth month) as it was then, was renamed in honor of first Roman Emperor Augustus.
- The month was also lengthened from 30 to 31 days, so that Augustus's month equaled Julius Cesar's month: July.
- In the United States, it is National Goat Cheese month.
- August's birthstones are peridot and or sardonyx.
- It is the eighth month of the year in the Gregorian Calendar and is one of seven months to contain 31 days.
- A month-long collection of arts and cultural festivals take place in Edinburgh, Scotland every August.
- There are more vacations and holidays taken in this month more than any other.
- In the Southern Hemisphere, August is the seasonal equivalent of February in the Northern Hemisphere.
