# Biometric Screening Reminder

Your opportunity to complete the Biometric Screening for Ascend to Wholeness is next week on Wednesday and Thursday, May 16 & 17. If you

have not done so already, register for the screening online at <a href="www.ascendtowholeness.org">www.ascendtowholeness.org</a> and set up your biometric screening appointment through the link or by visiting <a href="www.screeningreg.com">www.screeningreg.com</a>. (login: ascend, password: healthy). Every member and covered spouse needs to have a screening to be eligible to participate in the Accelerate program in 2019. There are appointment times available on both days for all covered employees & spouses, whether you are on the Accelerate plan or Access plan. If you can't make those dates there is a 3<sup>rd</sup> date available on June 13 at Gem State Academy.

Please remember to bring your Healthcare ID card with you to your appointment. Drink plenty of water and wear sleeves that roll up easily to allow for the BP check. This screening should take approximately 15-25 minutes. – Michelle Sinigaglio, HR Director
