The Red Cross will be here on Monday, February 25, for a Pacific Press blood drive. They'll be in the Owyhee Room from 10:00 am to 3:00

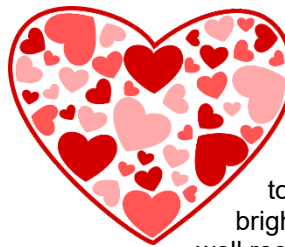
