**How can your PPPA family help you settle in?**

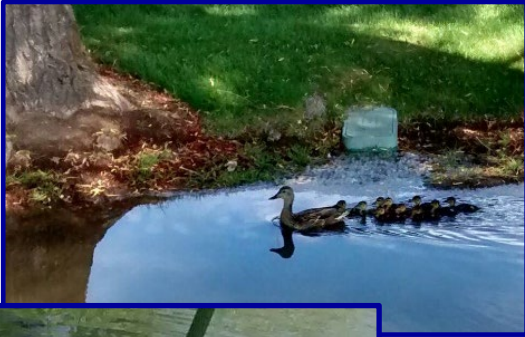
