### Pacific Press Display at NAD

Visitors to the new North American Division office building in Columbia, Maryland will be able to view a beautiful display featuring Pacific Press—who we are, what we do, and our history.

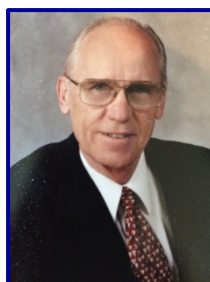
NAD has invited Pacific Press to set up a permanent display at a prominent location in its headquarters building—directly across from the president's office and the executive board room on the fourth floor. The new PPPA exhibit, designed by Adler Displays, was unveiled just in time for the North American Division year-end meetings when church leaders from around North America were in attendance.

Among the items on display is the very first copy of *The Desire of Ages* to come off the press and binding line at Pacific Press in 1892. (This is the very first *The Desire of Ages* ever produced anywhere.) The Pacific Press exhibit is part of an intentional plan by the Division to feature its institutions and ministries so that visitors will have an opportunity to see who we are as a church in North America.

### Robert J. Kloosterhuis



We are sorry to report that Elder Robert J. Kloosterhuis, 87, passed away Sunday, November 3, at 7:35 am at Advent Health, Fish Memorial Hospital, in Orange City, Florida.

Elder Kloosterhuis was Pacific Press Board of Directors Chairman from 1985 to 2000. He

always spoke highly of Pacific Press and our employees—and was a big supporter of Adventist Publishing.

He was President of the newly formed Africa-Indian Ocean Division from 1980 to 1985 after which he became Vice President of the General Conference while Neal Wilson, Robert Folkenberg, and Jan Paulsen were presidents. During his retirement, Elder Kloosterhuis took on special assignments for the General Conference and later was assistant to President Ted Wilson for assignments in India until he stopped working in 2013. He awaits the resurrection.
