On Sunday, December 8 we had our annual Pacific Press Christmas Party and we enjoyed a fun evening!

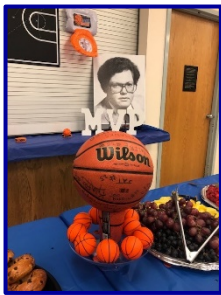
We want to thank the Social Committee for putting this event together.
