## Children's Magazines at work February is Black History in Florida Prison Ministries

After learning of incarcerated mothers bartering necessities for a tube of toothpaste to send to their child, Frank Barton developed the L.A.M.B. program (Love A Mother's Baby).

Through prison ministries programs organized on site in Florida prisons, mothers and fathers can request sponsorship for their children. The L.A.M.B. program sponsors provide support for the children and their caregivers, as well as supply gifts that the mothers put their names on, and caregivers give to the children for occasions such as Christmas and birthdays.

Mother and child also receive a subscription to a magazine commensurate with the age of the child, such as Our Little Friend, Primary Treasure or Guide. Florida Conference, local churches and free-will offerings fund the program.
