Victor came to work at Pacific Press back in April of 2015 in the IT Department as a Lead Programmer/Analyst,

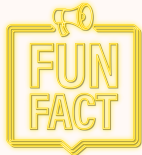
He was instrumental in developing several programs that have increased our efficiency. His devotional talks were always uplifting and he will be greatly missed.

Did You Know?

If you account for all of the countries that grow potatoes in the world, somewhere, at any given point in time, potatoes are probably being planted and likewise harvested. Harvest usually happens once a year, and most areas only get one crop.

In Idaho, we can store the potatoes grown and harvested between August and October in large potato cellars, sometimes referred to as a potato shed. This is where the potatoes are taken out of storage and washed, then sorted into consumer bags or foodservice cartons for fresh consumption.

Below is a picture of what Idaho® potatoes typically look like in storage. These facilities can be as long as a football field! The 2012 harvest (picture) was a nice crop—about 12 billion pounds of potatoes.
