

Mom was born in Rosholt, Wisconsin February 8, 1934 and moved to Idaho with her parents when she was 18 months old.

At the age of 8 the family moved from Caldwell, Idaho to the remote mining town of Stibnite, Idaho where they lived until she was 18 yrs. old. (Stibnite is 12 miles northeast of Yellowpine, Idaho) Mom loved her years growing up in Stibnite and entertained everyone with stories from her years there.

She attended Union College in Lincoln, Nebraska where she earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing. She met my father while working on her clinical studies at Boulder Sanitarium. They were married June 8, 1958. They raised four children DJ, Gene, Carole and Wayne, sending all through our SDA educational system.

Southwest District Health Department was formed in 1967. Three months later mom started working for the Health Department. She dedicated 30+ years of service to the State, 20+ as Director of Physical Health for Southwest District Health.

During retirement she loved wildflower photography and identification. She was a contributing member of the Idaho Botanical Society. Mom was active in the Caldwell Seventh-day Adventist Church, where she was a baptized member for 79 years!

Mom passed away on May 9, 2023 and is resting and awaiting Jesus soon return. Our family will miss her laughter and stories as well as the joy that she brought to everyone she met.
